Appellants Taylor Shellfish Company, Inc. and Pacific Coast Shellfish Growers Association's joint motion to file an oversized reply (No. 20-35546, Docket Entry No. 25; No. 20-35547, Docket Entry No. 15) is granted.

Appellants' motions to stay (No. 20-35546, Docket Entry Nos. 4 and 6; No. 20-35547, Docket Entry No. 2) the district court's June 11, 2020 order pending appeal are denied. *See Hilton v. Braunskill*, 481 U.S. 770, 776 (1987).

The motion to consolidate these appeals is granted. Appeal Nos. 20-35546 and 20-35547 are consolidated.

The following briefing schedule shall govern these consolidated appeals: the consolidated opening brief and excerpts of record are due September 28, 2020; the answering briefs are due October 28, 2020; and the consolidated optional reply brief is due within 21 days after service of the answering briefs. Appellees are

encouraged to join in a single answering brief to the greatest extent practicable.
